Congratulations to our newest Board Director, Dennis Neal. The Board is now fully staffed with 7 members.

Road Map for Re-entry was shared at the 12-12-23 Board Meeting. Owners can now enter, please let Karen Marszalec know via email prior to entering the building. If you want to bring a contractor in, again, please let Karen know. Contractors CANNOT commence work until further notice but are welcome to come provide measures and estimates to owners.

See photos – the City has placed a large sand berm along the sand roadway behind the Riviera. It is about 4 feet high but has not been compacted and leveled. We will continue to monitor this, but it should help keep some water away from the Riviera. The Board is moving approximately \$800K to 1 Month CD's for higher interest rates, to gain additional interest for the Association.
